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Abstract

Developing Transnational Cooperation on the Path of European Universities Project aims, multilateral partnerships between organisations active in the field of higher education between Central Asia(Region 6)&Europe. Virtual Exchange (VE) is a practice, supported by research, that consists of sustained, technology-enabled, people-to-people education programmes or activities in which constructive communication and interaction takes place between individuals or groups who are geographically separated and/or from different cultural backgrounds, with the support of educators or facilitators. Virtual Exchange combines the deep impact of intercultural dialogue and exchange with the broad reach of digital technology. Systematic Design Model in Extended Reality (XR) Applications for Central Asia, Virtual Exchange Project and general objective of the Erasmus+ CBHE initiative is to link young people (aged 18-30), youth workers, youth organisations, students, and academics from Europe and the Central Asia through online learning activities in order to strengthen people-to-people contacts and intercultural dialogue. Within the scope of the project, activities will be conducted to identify today's central asia youth problems and to ensure the sustainability of the project. Considering the results of the survey, the problems of people between the ages of 18-30 who are in higher education will be divided into categories according to the majority of the answers. On the webinar to be prepared for the Exchange program, online training will be provided on language learning and today's youth problems within the scope of the second language learning principle-based curriculum. Finally, under the HE established within the scope of Virtual Exchange, it is aimed to organize and participate in activities such as performance events in order to encourage people between the ages of 18-30 to learn language and today's youth problems, and to provide employment in cyber education area.
